

ALEKSANDAR ALJOŠA JOVANOVIĆ, UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR AND AMATEUR ASTRONOMER

We present the biography of the mathematician Aleksandar Jovanović (1949-2020), a distinguished professor at the Faculty of Mathematics, University of Belgrade. Professor Jovanović was well known not only as an excellent and talented mathematician, but also for his numerous activities in other fields in which astronomy had a special place. Although his main work lies in mathematical logic, Jovanović also successfully dealt with computing, signal processing and applications of these disciplines in biomedicine. He has published close to 100 scientific papers, several university textbooks and monographs. He was also a participant in a large number of domestic and foreign scientific conferences. He was a builder of amateur astronomical telescopes. He also had a very rich and interesting life outside of science, and some details from that part of his biography are highlighted in this paper as well.
