

BOSCOVICH'S STAY IN VIENNA

From April 5th, 1757 to March 4th, 1758, Roger Boscovich stayed in Vienna, where he was an expert and leader on behalf of the Republic of Luka in its dispute with the Duchy of Tuscany, which built dams on the border river which caused floods in the fields of Luka. During that stay, Boscovich wrote his monumental work "Theory of Natural Philosophy". In the paper, we show the reasons and place of his stay in Vienna.
