SOME UNKNOWN FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES OF MILUTIN MILANKOVIĆ AT THE FACULTY OF PHILOSOPHY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BELGRADE

Unexpectedly, when I recently dealt with another topic in the Archives of Serbia, I found several documents in the archive fund of the Faculty of Philosophy that explicitly testify about the functions and activities that Milutin Milanković had at the Faculty of Philosophy of the University of Belgrade in the mid-1920s. From these documents we learn, which until now (at least to me) was unknown, that (1923) he was appointed director of the Geophysical Institute of the University, that he was the first head of the Department of Sciences, when the Faculty of Philosophy was divided (1924) into two departments, Historical-philological and the Department of (natural-mathenatical) Sciences. Some of Milanković's activities are also listed there – a member of the University Council committee, as well as some his propositions.
