GNOMON FROM THE VILLAGE OF DONJI DRIJEN IN HERZEGOVINA

A unique gnomon that is part of the wall of the building is presented. It was located on the "čardak" (house) of the Krmek family in the village of Donji Drijen (Neum municipality). Today, that family house no longer exists, not even in its foundations. Its appearance is shown only by a bad photocopy from the reconstruction report. The gnomon was made by the so-called "companions" hemispheres placed horizontally, which stood at the corner of the house under the canopy. Only members of the Krmek family could tell what time it was. An attempt to reconstruct the gnomon is presented.
