

MILAN NEDELJKOVIĆ AND HIS CARE FOR COMMISSIONED ASTRONOMICAL INSTRUMENTS AFTER RETIREMENT

For researchers of the history of Astronomical Observatory of Belgrade, the very interesting, but insufficiently known, question is, whether, and if yes until when, Milan Nedeljković occupied himself with Observatory after retirement in 1924, and before the arrival of his successor on the position of the head, Vojislav Mišković, in 1926. This question is clarified with the, until now unknown, letter, presented in this work, sent on 16th of June 1925, to the Minister of Education, by Milan Nedeljković, concerned for the integral delivery of commissioned instruments for Observatory, which was questioned at one moment. The letter inform as well, who helped him significantly, particularly with his pleading in Berlin.
