

NON REALIZED IDEA OF PROF. ŽIVOJIN ČULUM

Early in 1977th the physicist, prof. of University of Novi Sad, Živojin Čulum, then president of the Society of mathematicians, physicists and astronomers of Vojvodina, and president of the Astronomical Society "Novi Sad", proposed to the Astronomical Observatory in Belgrade, the interesting idea to build a joint observational station at Fruška Gora. The station, according to his idea, should have a scientific and educational character, for the University needs and for the smaller scientific programs. It would be the common for seismologists, meteorologists and astronomers, for which was interested as well and Yugoslav army. This paper deals with the presentation of this idea and circumstances in which it was proposed.
