

IVAN PAKVOR

Astronomer Ivan Pakvor came to the Astronomical Observatory in early sixties, after mounting of the fundamental astrometrical instruments, at the time of their experimental work. After a short work on the large meridian circle, he moved to the Group for the absolute right ascension and almost the entire lifetime of work dedicated to the great passage instrument, which then, with its system of vacuum mirae, was a unique instrument in the world. This paper is a brief overview of his life and work on the Observatory, and of published scientific papers.
